Step 3. Have each student create a sentence for every word. Make sure at least 20 students participate.


Step 4. Assist students in forming sentences using proper English. Emphasize correctness over complexity.

1.2 Vocabulary

Word	Meaning	Example Sentence
Screening	The showing of a movie or television show to a select audience	The cinema-hall had a special screening of the new film.
Cozy	Warm and comfortable, often in a small space	The fireplace made the living room feel cozy and inviting.
Grab	To take hold of something quickly	She reached out to grab her favorite book from the shelf.
Gathering	A coming together of people for a purpose	The family had a gathering to celebrate a special occasion.
Mystery	Something that is not understood or known	The locked box was a mystery; nobody knew what was inside.
Intriguing	Capturing interest or curiosity	The detective story had an intriguing plot with many twists.
Upcoming	Happening in the near future	The upcoming weekend is filled with exciting plans.
Excitement	A feeling of enthusiasm or eagerness	The children showed great excitement before opening

		their presents.
Concert	A musical performance in which several vocal or instrumentalists perform together	We bought tickets to the upcoming concert featuring our favorite band.
