Step 2. Clarify the meaning and usage of each word to the students.


Step 3. Have each student create a sentence for every word. Make sure at least 20 students participate.

| Word | Meaning | Example Sentence |
|----------------------------|--|---|
| Delve | To investigate or explore deeply | The students will delve into the mysteries of the ancient city. |
| Incredible | Unbelievable or extraordinary | The magician performed incredible tricks that amazed everyone. |
| Significant | Important or having notable effects | Planting trees is significant for the environment. |
| Squirrels | Small rodents with bushy tails, often found in trees | The park is home to many playful squirrels. |
| Cozy | Warm and comfortable, often in a small space | The cabin in the woods felt cozy with its fireplace. |
| Bustling | Full of activity or lively | The city market is bustling with shoppers and vendors. |
| Scorching Hot | Extremely hot and burning | The desert can be scorching hot during the daytime. |
| Little Nod of Appreciation | A small gesture expressing approval or recognition | She gave him a little nod of appreciation for his hard work. |
