Step 4. Assist students in forming sentences using proper English. Emphasize correctness over complexity.



Spanning	Extending across or covering a period of time	The bridge spanning the river was an engineering marvel.

Metamorphosis	A complete change or transformation	The caterpillar's metamorphosis into a butterfly is a fascinating process.
Advent	The arrival or beginning of something significant	The advent of the Internet revolutionized communication.
Propelled	Driven forward or impelled	Technological advancements have propelled society into the digital age.
Cornerstone Innovation	A fundamental and crucial innovation	The invention of the wheel was a cornerstone innovation in transportation.
